

**NOTICE OF TOWN ELECTION  
TOWN OF ANGIER, NORTH CAROLINA**

A NONPARTISAN ELECTION will be held on **NOVEMBER 8, 2011**, in the Town of Angier, North Carolina to elect a **Mayor and four (4) commissioners**. Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. The Polling place for voters of Angier will be the Angier Elementary School located at 130 E. McIver Street, Angier, NC. Canvass of the vote shall be held on November 15, 2011 at 11:00 a.m. at the Harnett County Board of Elections Office in Lillington, NC.

Absentee ballots are allowed. Requests for an absentee ballot must be made in writing to the Board of Elections Office and received in the County Board of Elections office by 5:00 p.m. on November 1, 2011. Absentee ballots must be received in the Board of Elections Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 7, 2011. The Board of Elections will meet on October 18, 2011 at 5:00 p.m., October 25, 2011 at 5:00 p.m., November 1, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. and November 8, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. and other times as may be necessary for the purpose of approving absentee ballots. One-stop voting will be held in the Board of Elections Office beginning October 20, 2011 and ending Saturday, November 5, 2011. One-stop voting hours are Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on Saturday, November 5, 2011 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

All residents of the Town of Angier who are registered to vote with the Harnett County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Voters who are previously registered need not re-register for this election. Those residents of the town who are not registered to vote must register on or before **October 14, 2011** to be eligible to vote in this election. However, residents of the town may register and vote at the Board of Elections during the one-stop period listed above. Any voter who has moved since the last election must notify the Board of Elections in writing by that same date. A person may register at the Board of Elections Office at 308 W. Duncan Street, Lillington, NC or by calling the Board of Elections Office at 910-893-7553 and requesting a mail-in application to register to vote.
